- Building a greener future by reducing the environmental footprint of development projects for our operations (design, construction, renovation).

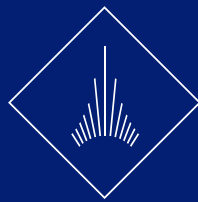
### Developing with Local Communities
